

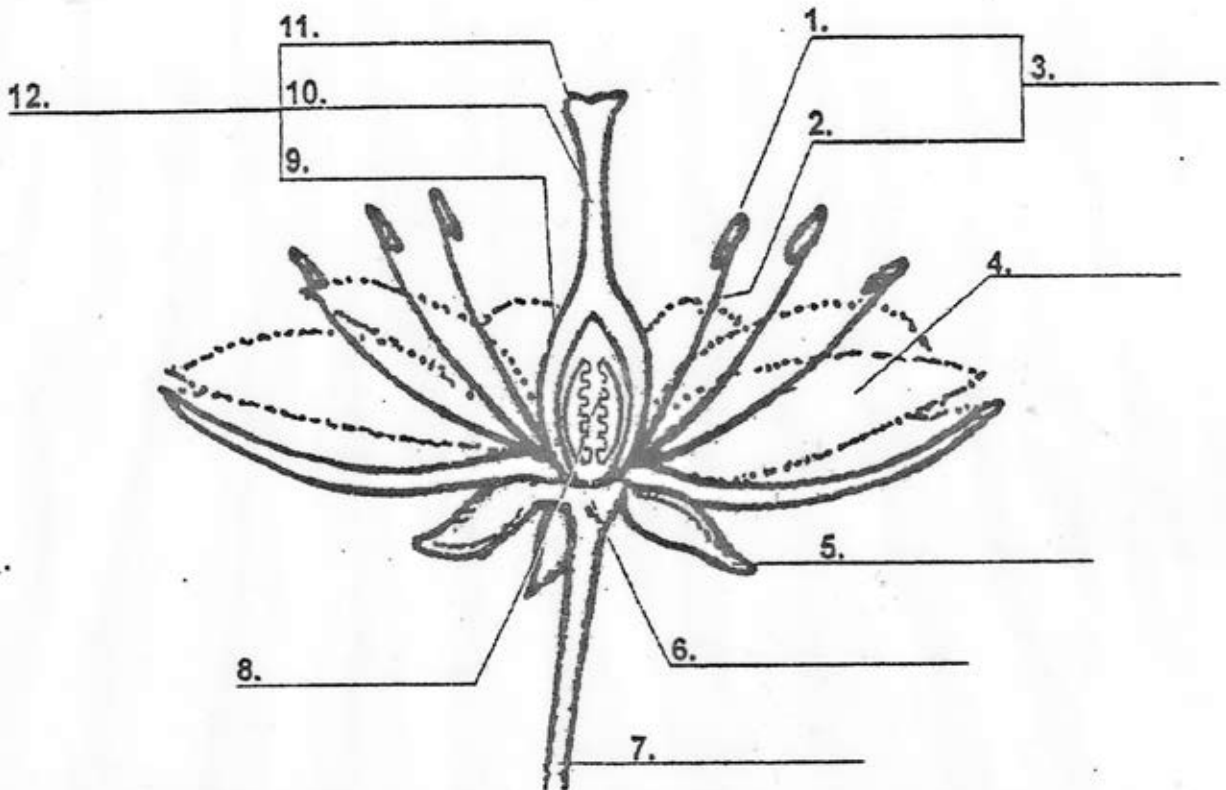
FLOWER ANATOMY SHEET

- D. sticky surface at the top of the pistil; it traps and holds pollen
- E. tube-like structure that holds up the stigma
- F. when fertilized becomes a seed
- G. when fertilized becomes the fruit
- H. the pollen-bearing part of the stamen
- I. the stalk that holds the anther
- J. male organ of a flower
- K. part of the stem from where flower organs grow
- L. the stalk bearing a flower
