Overview: The Edible Schoolyard Project Stockton provides edible education experiences for youth and adults, no-cost local, organic produce, and access to land for the south Stockton community. The Edible Schoolyard is excited to announce a new program offering no-cost field trips to schools in San Joaquin County at the Community Farm at 466 S Ventura Avenue in Stockton. The field trip program will offer students the opportunity to learn about healthy foods, sustainable agriculture practices, and enjoy a day outside on a beautiful urban farm.

Field Trip Details:

- The Edible Schoolyard Community Farm can host several classes per day but these groups must be booked two weeks in advance.
- The Edible Schoolyard Community Farm hosts field trips for K-12th grade students. This includes charter schools and homeschool groups.
- The Edible Schoolyard Community Farm offers half day field trips if needed for kindergarten through third grade classes by request.
- The Edible Schoolyard Project can provide ELA or science standard-aligned lesson plans for all activities if needed.
