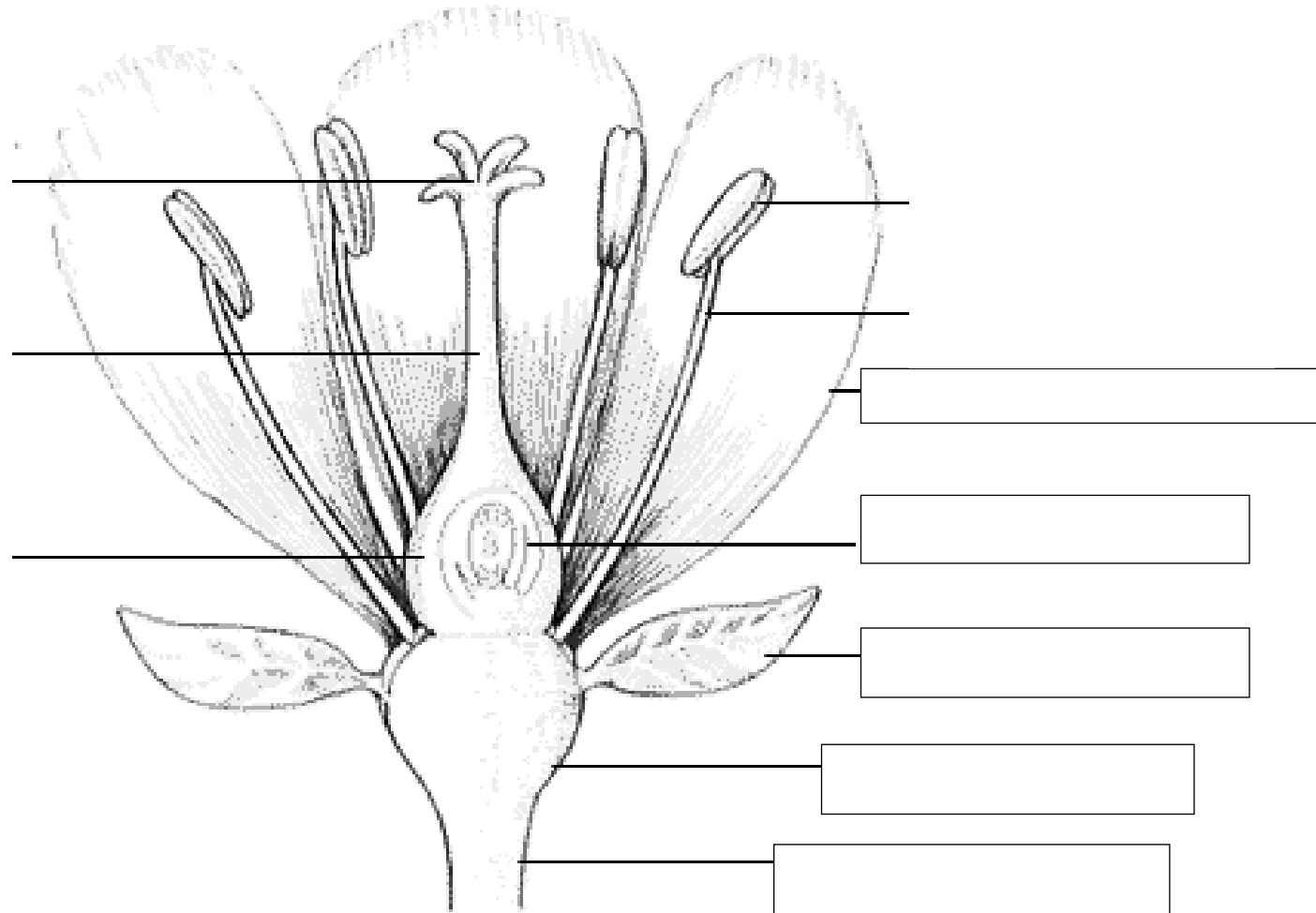

Flower Labeling

Directions: Can you identify the scientific names for the parts of a flower? Look at the definition and label that part of the plant with the correct word.



Peduncle: The stalk of a flower.

Receptacle: The central part of a flower stalk where the parts of the flower are attached.

Sepal: The outer parts of the flower (often green and leaf-like) that enclose a developing bud.

Petal: The parts of a flower that are often conspicuously colored .

Directions: Draw and describe the different parts of your flower. If you are not able to print this sheet, draw on a piece of paper.

What does the stalk of your flower, the **Peduncle**, look like?

What does the **receptacle**, the part of the stalk that attaches to your flower, look like?
