

Community Farm Field Trips

Now booking for Spring 2023!

Overview: The Edible Schoolyard is hosting no-cost field trips for schools at the Community Farm at 466 S Ventura Avenue in Stockton. The field trip program will offer students the opportunity to learn about healthy foods, sustainable agriculture practices, and enjoy a day outside on a beautiful urban farm. Students will get to try their hand at a variety of farm tasks, participate in a cooking demonstration, and enjoy connecting with the natural environment. Field trips are available for classes 3rd grade and up from local schools.

Field Trip Details:

- Dates are available now in March, April, and May on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
- The Edible Schoolyard Community Farm can host one class (up to 35 students) a day.
- The Edible Schoolyard Project will provide a cooking lesson that includes a small snack, but students should bring their own lunches or school lunch.
